Coronavirus: CPL has measures in place

Since early December 2019, there has been an increasing number of cases of respiratory disease caused by a novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) emerged from Wuhan, the capital of central China's Hubei province. Most of the cases appeared within China, but the virus has started to spread in Europe in the last days.

Cartonplast is continuously evaluating the risks related to the coronavirus situation in all the countries where we operate. Based on the current status and our knowledge, herewith we confirm that there is no risk, which could lead to disruption of our operation activities.

As our reusable plastic layer pads (PLPs) are used in the food and beverage, pharmaceutical and cosmetic industries we can also confirm, that there is no risk to the safety of our product and products transported on PLPs. Cleaning technology which we use to clean and disinfect our PLPs makes the product safe for the intended use. In all our cleaning facilities for the final disinfection of the PLPs we use a product which is effective against coronavirus.


